## CLINICAL AND SCIENTIFIC FIELDS OF COMPETENCE:

### *- Minimal Invasive Surgery*

including endoscopic, laparoscopic and robotic surgery of the adrenal, kidney, ureter, bladder and prostate for benign and malignant disease.

### *- Retroperitoneal Surgery*

including endoscopic and open stone surgery; nephron-sparing tumor resection; laparoscopic tumor nephrectomy; tumor nephrectomy with resection of caval thrombi; thoracoabdominal approach for very large kidney or adrenal tumors and local recurrence of kidney tumors; renal transplantation (cadaveric and living donor)

### *- Radical Tumor Surgery in the Small Pelvis*

including robotic, retropubic and perineal radical prostatectomy, radical and ultraradical cystectomy/anterior exenteration; anterior exenteration for gynecological tumors in cooperation with Gynecological Surgeons; complete exenteration for intestinal tumors in cooperation with General Surgery.

### *- Reconstruction of the Lower Urinary Tract*

reconstructive surgery of the lower urinary tract utilizing intestinal segments including orthotopic, heterotopic and rectal continent urinary diversions in men and women; also including special indications for urinary diversions like in patients with significant anatomical malformations, in patients with transplanted kidneys, after irradiation; diagnostic procedures (including video urodynamics) and surgery for urinary incontinence including fascial and alloplastic slings; colposuspension; sacral bladder denervation; implantation of bladder pacemakers.

### *- Pediatric Urology*

endoscopic and open stone surgery of kidney, ureter and bladder; diagnostic and treatment of anatomical malformations of the upper and lower urinary tract (double kidneys, ureteropelvic obstruction, vesico-ureteral reflux, urethral valves); surgery for malignant adrenal and renal tumors (neuroblastoma, nephroblastoma); surgery for malignant pediatric tumors in the small pelvis (rhabdomyosarcoma of bladder, prostate and vagina); reconstructive surgery of the lower urinary tract utilizing intestinal segments.
